#### Securing the safe


To reduce the risk of theft it is essential that your safe is securely fixed. Please use the included bolts and secure to a solid concrete floor.


For maximum performance and correct installation a professional locksmith is recommended to install the safe.



This product is heavy. Incorrect installation may result in injury.

#### First time operating a new Safe







- Open the safe using the manual override key.
- Remove the battery cover located on the rear of the door.
- Place the batteries according to the illustration at the back of the battery compartment. Once the batteries are installed, close the battery compartment. Before using your Yale safe you must insert batteries. The safe requires 4 "AA" (1.5V R06) - which are included.

When batteries need changing the display will show Lo-bAL during operation.


- Close the safe using the manual override Key
- Please note, when the safe is opened by manual override key, it must be closed by the manual override key too. Otherwise the locking mechanism may be damaged.



#### Set/re-set your user code







(For re-programming the Administration Code, please follow the instruction in the Administration section in the user manual.) Press SET . Enter the new user code (3-6 digits). Press to complete the user

panel. Enter the user code or use Administration Mode to unlock the safe.


It is important for user to re-program the User Code and Administration Code for a new Safe unit as soon as it is in place.

The user code may only be programmed when the safe is unlocked by the electronic

The display ELOSE- will confirm that the new code is set and door will be locked at the same time. The new code will be displayed for ~2 seconds. (The display of new code can be canceled by setting in Administration Mode, please see Administration Setting part for details)






Please note, your user code does not have to be reprogrammed when you change the batteries.

### Opening the safe


#### 1 Press User Code






- 1 Press user code


The sound on/off option does not affect the alarm sounding of 3 consecutive wrong entries.

- 2 Press . The bolts engage, locking the door and the display shows £L05E-.
- Please note that if the safe is unlocked by manual override key, it can only be locked by the manual override key. If the safe is unlocked by electronic key code, it can only be locked by the electronic key. Forcing the safe to lock/unlock by different means may damage the internal locking mechanism causing permanent failure in the lock.
- Please note, if an incorrect user code is entered, the display will show "Error" and the door will not open. If the wrong user code is entered 3 consecutive times an alarm will sound for approximately 1 minute. The safe will be locked down for approximately 3 minutes. During this time, the safe cannot be unlocked by electronic user code.

### Using the manual override key




1 To open the safe place the key in the key hole behind the Yale logo. The key can only be inserted one way. Turn the key clockwise to fully retract the locking bolts.



Please do not store the mechanical override keys inside the safe




Please note, gentle force should be used when inserting, turning or retracting the key. When the key is operated correctly the force needed to operate is light. Incorrect operation by brutal force may damage the lock.

### Administration mode



- Press student twice to activate the Administration entry mode.
- 2 Press the Administration pass code and then press button to enter.
- If the Administration pass code is entered correctly, it will display EE--.
- **4** User can then make different settings under the Administration Mode.
- To exit the Administration Mode, either press or it will exit automatically after idle for approximately 20 seconds.
- The default ex-factory Administration Code is 000000. After the Administration Code is reprogrammed, Please remember it well and keep it in a secure place. Once it is re-programmed, the default ex-factory Administration Code CANNOT be used again to unlock the safe.

## Unlock the safe in Administration mode

- 1 Under the Administration Mode, enter 00 and then press Lock.
- 2 The display will show OPEREd and the door will open.

## Reset the Administration Code

- 1 Under the Administration Mode, enter 01 and then press LOCK.
- 2 The display will show MEC RC.
- 3 Enter the new Administration Code and then press
- 4 The display will show REPERT.
- 5 Enter the new Administration Code again for confirmation and then press Lock
- 6 If the new Administration Code is successfully registered the display will show 500d. Otherwise it will show Error and no new Administration Code would be set.

### Quick Locking Time Limit On/Off

## Show/hide digits while entering code


- 1 Under the Administration Mode, enter 03 and then press to toggle between display on/off.

  Default setting is on.
- If display d15 0F, it shows "-" only when a code is entered and the code will not be displayed after locking.
- If display 415 077, the code will be shown during it is entered and the code will be displayed after locking.
- 1 Under the Administration Mode, enter 04 and then press to toggle between the Quick Locking time limit on/off.


  Default setting is OFF.
  - If display OLE OF, when user press to lock the safe, it will always lock with the same User Code no matter how long the safe had been unlocked and idled.
  - If display ULE UT, when user press
     to lock the safe, it will lock with the same User Code within 5 minutes.
     If the safe is unlocked and idled for more than 5 minutes, a new user code must be set in order to lock the safe.

## Battery replacement warning


When the battery is about to run out, the display will flash  $L \circ -bRE$  during operation. User should replace with new batteries as soon as possible.



Mark the position of the safe through fixing holes.



Properties 2 Remove the safe and drill the holes as marked. If needed, drop the plugs in the drilled holes.




### Installing the safe

To reduce the risk of theft it is essential that your safe is securely fixed. Please use the provided bolts to fix the safe horizontally and secure to a solid concrete floor or wall.

For your convenience, there are fixing holes both in the bottom and on the back, please fix the safe correctly according to below diagrams.

Reposition the safe over the holes. Drop the screws and washers though the safe into the drilled holes.



Tighten the fixing bolts firmly and ensure there is no movement of the safe.
